#### **Finance Discussion**

- Review of prepared documents
- Discussion of loan payment process
  - Desired state: Loan payment comes out of operating account, not pool account.
  - Need to make sure loan payment is accounted for in our annual budgeting process
  - Interest in seeing if a cash flow document is possible a finance document that brings together investing, expenses, etc in one place
  - Some accounting adjustments to make (e.g. moving some Office Admin expense to Lifeguard)
- Pool expenses to date have been primarily for architect work (e.g. pool and landscape), permits, fees, legal, etc.
- Tennis court updates this should come out of appropriate capital reserve fund (e.g. \$21k for tennis lights)
- Morgan Stanley account update: \$9.9k to go to county investment fund

- Seniors make up ~100 members, awesome turn out, especially at BBQs
- Opening Day was chilly
  - Karen Fryling hosted a kids joke-athon, really fun thank you!!

- Swim team

- Tennis Camp/Lessons have worked through a recent transition from Bryan to Yoav and Jack all good!

- California Parks and Rec Grant Update
  - Work on this remains in progress
  - Legal team involved; working through a deed issue
  - To receive funds, current understanding is that we first spend and then we go for reimbursement
