 - We would like to even out those challenges next year.
 - What we propose
 - Hire a maintenance manager who also lifeguards and is able and interested in growing with us to further enhance the experience of our membership.
 - Would like someone to be able to start early.
 - Program management administrative side. Every time we start a class it requires a new setup to get everything going.
 - Need to think about budget and compensation.

- San Jose State has a rec program maybe there is an intern-like role. Can we provide class credits for the job. Perhaps we could develop a funnel of students?
- The Staffing Committee (Leslie, Bob) will coordinate with Jane and Sarah on how to make some progress.

Pool Report

- Last Thursday the building dept. came and they signed off. Need yellow bumpers for the ADA stall.
- Today civil signed off.
 - Geotech was closed after the architect worked with the county to get closure.
- All will be done once we add the yellow bumper for ADA parking stall.
- Donor wall is still in progress shipping soon and working on how the wall will be mounted.
